All these batteries types still have regulatory requirements, so must be correctly identified and packed before shipping with DHL. In the instance of multiple, loose batteries, terminals must be protected by individual packaging and separated within the box by dividers. Use plenty of filler packaging so that the batteries don't move around.
