Modern robots can move with incredible agility, mimicking animal locomotion and executing complex tasks with mechanical precision. In many ways, they rival biology in coordination and efficiency. Robots could one day harvest energy from high-energy-density materials such as aluminum through synthetic digestive and vascular systems.
