Replacement agricultural land will be as close as possible to the land that was lost and is acceptable to the DPs. All replacement land for agriculture, residential and business use will be provided with secured tenure status and without any additional cost, taxes, and surcharges to the DPs at the time of transfer.

Involuntary Land Acquisition refers to the process whereby a person or entity is compelled by a public agency to alienate all or part of the land a person/entity owns or possesses, to the ownership and possession of that agency for public purpose in return for a consideration.
