How many solar PV projects are being built in Italy?

GreenIT and Galileo sign agreement on eight solar PV projects in Italy. GreenIT continues its growth in renewable energy with an additional 140 MW portfolio of new solar photovoltaic plants developed by Galileo. The projects will be built in three regions in Southern, Central and Northern Italy.

What is the largest photovoltaic project in Italy?

The project, called Fenix, will start construction in March and will mark an unprecedented event in the Italian energy landscape as the largest photovoltaic project under construction in the country. Italy currently has only 60 plants of more than 10 MW, and the average project is 26 MW.

How much does a solar project cost in Italy?

He has been reporting on solar and renewable energy since 2009. Italy's energy agency has awarded 300 MW of solar capacity at 34 locations, but it only selected a 6 MW wind project in its latest auction. All developers offered a maximum discount ranging from 2% to 3.02% off the auction ceiling price of EUR0.065 (\$0.07)/kWh.

How many photovoltaic plants are there in Italy?

Italy currently has only 60 plants of more than 10 MW, and the average project is 26 MW. When operational, with its 424,638 photovoltaic modules, the plant will generate around 400 GWh per year, avoiding the emission of 119,000 tonnes of CO₂ into the atmosphere.

Why is Galileo launching a Renewable Project in Italy?

In Italy, Galileo is developing a further pipeline of onshore and offshore renewable projects accounting for a grand total of more than 2,000 MW in the country. Efficient synergies with such high-calibre partners like GreenIT can be strong propellers for the further expansion of our activities across Europe.

Where is RWE building its first solar plant in Italy?

RWE has started the construction of its first solar plant in Italy. Bosco, an 8.3 megawatt (MWac) ground-mounted solar plant, will be installed in Partinico Municipality near Palermo, Sicily.
