<div class="df_qntext">Where are Saudi Arabia's oil reserves located?

Saudi Arabia - Strategic Reserves and Aramco Power Saudi Arabia ranks second globally in proven crude oil reserves,with an estimated 267 billion barrels as of 2024. The majority of these reserves are located in the Eastern Province,including the massive Ghawar Field,the world's largest onshore oil field.

<div class="df_qntext">How much oil does Saudi Arabia have?

The Saudi reserves are about one-fifth of the world's total conventional oil reserves. A large fraction of these reserves comes from a small number of very large oil fields,and past production amounts to 40% of the stated reserves. Other sources state that Saudi Arabia has about 297.7 billion barrels.

<div class="df_qntext">What is the largest oil field in the world?

Measuring 280 by 30 km (170 by 19 mi) (some 8,400 square kilometres (3,200 sq mi)),it is by far the largest conventional oil field in the world,and accounts for roughly a third of the cumulative oil production of Saudi Arabia as of 2018. Ghawaris entirely owned and operated by Saudi Aramco,the state-run Saudi oil company.

It is located about 265 kilometres (165 mi) north of the company headquarters in Dhahran on the coast of the Persian Gulf,Saudi Arabia. Measuring 50 by 15 kilometres (31.1 by 9.3 mi),the field has a producing capability of more than 1.2 million barrels per day (190 × 10³ m³/d).

Jafurah,the largest unconventional natural gas field in Saudi Arabia,contains 229 Tcf in natural gas reserves,which includes 15 Tcf of additional proved reserves announced by the Saudi government in early 2024. Jafurah is under development,and initial start-up is planned for late 2025.

The Kingdom's oil types are: Arabian Heavy,Arabian Light,Arabian Very Light,and Medium crude oil,in addition to Arabian excellent. Oil fields and their facilities are situated at close distances from one another,most of which are located in the Eastern Province,such as the fields of Ghawar,Safaniya,Shaybah,Abqaiq,and Qatif.
