<div class="df_qntext">What are the shipping requirements for lithium batteries?

Some general shipping requirements to transport lithium batteries internationally include: Lithium batteries weighing over 35kg must be approved by the national authority of the shipping and destination country before shipment. Defective or damaged lithium batteries must not be transported.

<div class="df_qntext">What are the new packaging requirements for lithium ion batteries?

Revised Packing Instructions: More stringent requirements for UN-certified packaging, capable of withstanding specific drop tests. State of Charge (SoC) Emphasis: Increased scrutiny on the SoC for standalone lithium-ion battery shipments, with a general requirement not to exceed 30% of rated capacity.

<div class="df_qntext">Are lithium batteries shipped in a container?

There are three packaging categories for lithium batteries if they are being shipped in a container. When shipping lithium batteries, it is crucial to check the rules and regulations ahead of transportation, or work with an experienced shipping partner to ensure that your cargo is shipped following best practices.

<div class="df_qntext">What is a shipper's declaration for lithium ion batteries - 2025 OSS/cargo?

By signing the Shipper's Declaration, the shipper is making a legal statement that all the applicable provisions of the DGR have been complied with, which includes that the lithium ion batteries are at no more than 30% SoC. This declaration is part of the IATA Guidance Document for Lithium Batteries and Sodium ion Batteries - 2025 OSS/Cargo.

<div class="df_qntext">Are wet batteries safe to ship internationally?

Like lithium batteries, there are strict regulations to follow when shipping wet batteries internationally. An IATA Dangerous Goods label must be attached, along with the correct UN number and shipping name for the particular type of batteries.

<div class="df_qntext">What types of batteries can I mail or ship internationally?

There are many types of batteries that have different requirements when you wish to mail or ship them internationally: Wet batteries, also known as flooded lead-acid batteries, are commonly found in vehicles and backup power systems.
