Which country has the most solar power in Europe?

<div class="df_qntext">Which EU countries have the highest solar capacity?

Ranking of EU Countries by Installed Solar PV Capacity (2024). The Netherlands has the highest solar capacity per capita in the EU, due to aggressive rooftop solar policies. Southern countries (Greece, Spain, Malta, Portugal) dominate the top rankings, benefiting from high solar irradiance.

The United States conducted much early research in photovoltaics and concentrated solar power and is among the top countries in the world in deploying the technology, being home to 4 of the 10 largest utility-scale photovoltaic power stations in the world as of 2017.

<div class="df_qntext">Which country has the most solar power in Europe?

In terms of cumulative capacity, Germany with more than 24 GW, is the leading country in Europe, followed by Italy, with more than 12 GW. PV is now a significant part of Europe's electricity mix, producing 2% of the demand in the EU and roughly 4% of peak demand. PV roof-top system in Berlin, Germany.

<div class="df_qntext">Is Germany a good country to install photovoltaic solar?

Germany is among the top-4 ranked countries in terms of installed photovoltaic solar capacity. The overall capacity has reached 90 gigawatts (GW) by the end of 2024. Photovoltaics contribute more than 14% to the national electricity demands. Germany has seen an outstanding period of photovoltaic installations from 2010 until 2012.

Germany has regained its position as the leading country for solar installations in Europe, adding 14.1 GW in 2023. Following Germany, Spain and Italy have also made significant contributions, with 8.2 GW and 4.8 GW installed respectively. Poland and the Netherlands round out the top five with 4.6 GW and 4.1 GW, respectively.
