Dr. Arthur B. Cuthbert Walker II, one of the greatest solar physicists of all time, is known for his work on telescopes and solar physics. He was born in 1936 in Cleveland, Ohio, and later studied at the Case Institute of Technology, earning a bachelor's degree in physics. Walker then went on to earn a doctorate from the University of Illinois.

Prof. Green set up Australia's first solar research lab 50 years ago, in 1974. He said: "The dream of a world powered by sustainable energy sources of course motivated me hugely, but that we were about to set out on a path that would one day result in a seismic shift in global energy generation and consumption was not a given."

In the 1950s, Parker proposed the existence of the solar wind, which was initially met with skepticism but was later confirmed by NASA's Mariner 2 mission in 1962. This discovery revolutionized our understanding of the Sun and its influence on the solar system.
