

Wrap copper wire around the capacitor of the solar container circuit

<div class="df_qntext">Does wire wrap work with digital circuits?

Wire-wrap works well with digital circuits with few discrete components, but is less convenient for analog systems with many discrete resistors, capacitors or other components (such elements can be soldered to a header and plugged into a wire wrap socket).

<div class="df_qntext">How many turns does a wire-wrap connection take?

A correctly made wire-wrap connection for 30 or 28 AWG wire is seven turns (fewer for larger wire) of bare wire with half to one and a half turns of insulated wire at the bottom for strain relief. The square hard-gold-plated post thus forms 28 redundant contacts.

<div class="df_qntext">How do you wrap a circuit?

Just insert the cap in the extra pins, and then wire wrap it onto the circuit. Finally, but hand wrapping & unwrapping tools AND, BUY A CHEAP BATTERY OPERATED WRAPPING TOOL. YES, THEY ARE CHEAP. FINALLY, Again, I have built some pretty fast circuits with this technique too.

<div class="df_qntext">How do electronic components connect to an insulating board?

Electronic components mounted on an insulating board are interconnected by lengths of insulated wire run between their terminals, with the connections made by wrapping several turns of uninsulated sections of the wire around a component lead or a socket pin. Wires can be wrapped by hand or by machine, and can be hand-modified afterwards.

<div class="df_qntext">What is wire wrap?

Simple; it's a wire connection system that uses a special tool to tightly wrap a small gauge solid wire around the sharp corners of a connection post. Bell Telephone Laboratories developed the system, and OK Industries, which was founded in 1946, pioneered the process. Wire wrap has been around a long time.

<div class="df_qntext">How are wires wrapped?

Wires can be wrapped by hand or by machine, and can be hand-modified afterwards. It was popular for large-scale manufacturing in the 1960s and early 1970s, and continues today to be used for short runs and prototypes. The method eliminates the design and fabrication of a printed circuit board.
